

This is to Certify that on October 8, 2011, Daniel Simmonds rode a 2009 BMW R1200GS a total of 1,550 grueling miles in less than twenty-four hours starting in Grantsville, Maryland continuing on to Winchester, Virginia, Bristol, Virginia and Nashville, Tennessee before ending in Somerset, Pennsylvania while participating in the Bun Burner 1500 Gold.
