



This is to Certify that on the 14<sup>th</sup> of May 2013, Daniel Simmonds rode a BMW R1200GSA a total of 1,567 grueling miles in less than twenty-four hours starting in Gettysburg, Pennsylvania continuing on to Knoxville, Tennessee; Jackson, Tennessee and Wytheville, Virginia before ending in Martinsburg, West Virginia while participating in the Bun Burner 1500. Mr. Simmonds' stellar performance in smashing the twenty-four hour barrier during this difficult ride earned him entry into the Gold Medal record book.
