

This is to Certify that on the 19<sup>th</sup> of June 2015, Daniel Simmonds rode a Yamaha Super Ténéré a total of 1,566 grueling miles in less than twenty-four hours starting in Laramie, Wyoming; continuing on to North Platte, Nebraska; Des Moines, Iowa; and Columbus, Ohio before ending in Somerset, Pennsylvania while participating in the Bun Burner 1500 Gold. Mr. Simmonds' stellar performance in smashing the twenty-four hour barrier during this difficult ride earned him entry into the Gold Medal record book.

The Bun Burner 1500 GOLD, an extreme ride designed for an extreme rider, was conducted under very strict guidelines set forth by the Iron Butt Association. Only a handful of riders from around the world have managed to solve the equation of time, distance and endurance to complete the Bun Burner GOLD.
