



This is to certify that in August of 2016, Daniel Simmonds rode a Yamaha Super Tenere a total of 15,094 grueling miles in less than 240 hours (10 days) on an insane 10 lap ride starting in Caldwell, Idaho continuing on across southern Idaho to Snowville, Utah, down a remote high-desert 2-lane road and finally across northern Nevada to Reno, turning around and retracing his route back to Caldwell each day. Mr. Simmonds' stellar performance riding 10 sequential 1,509.4 mile days during this difficult ride earned him entry into the Bun Burner GOLD Deca record book.

The Bun Burner GOLD Deca, an extreme ride designed for an extreme rider, was conducted under very strict guidelines set forth by the Iron Butt Association. Dan Simmonds is the first person to ride and document ten 1,500+ mile days setting a 10 day mileage record along the way!
