This is to Certify that in June of 2018, Daniel Simmonds rode a 2014 Yamaha Super Tenere a total of 5,600 grueling miles in less than four days. Mr. Simmonds' ride started at the farthest Northwest point of the United States reachable by road at Prudhoe Bay, Alaska on the Arctic Ocean and took him on one of the most desolate and punishing dirt roads in North America, the Dalton "Highway", crossing the barren Arctic tundra. The ride continued across Canada and the United States to the farthest Southeast corner of the United States in Key West, Florida on the Atlantic Ocean.
